



## **SPW COVID-19 Vaccination Policy:**

**Policy Created & Ratified: 29-10-2021**

From 1st November 2021, Seymour Performers Workshop will require current government-issued proof of full vaccination against COVID-19 from those who are eligible for vaccination. SPW will refer to the current updates for vaccinations on the Victorian Department of Health and Human Services website:

This includes volunteers or members involved in SPW, on and off stage, through:

- Performance,
- Production,
- Musician,
- Orchestra player,
- Chorus member,
- Singer,
- Stage crew,
- Technical personnel,
- Front of House,
- Working Bees,
- Rehearsals,
- Committee Members,
- Any person attending an SPW event (including parents/carers),
- Paid contractors.

Note: This list is indicative of our common group activities, but extends to any activity being conducted by SPW, including Committee Meetings and group social gatherings.

If you are unable to be vaccinated, you will need to provide SPW with proof of government-issued medical exemption.

A vaccination certificate needs to be sighted by the Production Manager or a member of the SPW Committee prior to the first face to face activity. Participants who are not able to produce such documentation will be unable to attend.

SPW will adhere to all current government directives regarding COVID-19 vaccinations for members and audience members.
